

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, July 8, to Friday, July 12, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD answered more than 300 calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, July 8

- **1000 block of Ridge Road, harassment** – 911 caller assaulted by a female upset that her ex-boyfriend had been with the complainant the prior night. Patrols responded; report taken.
- **Center/N. Fourth streets, ordinance violation** – Officer initiated call. Caller reported a male sleeping on benches, which is prohibited. Patrols located a male sitting on the bench, holding a cell phone and wearing ear buds. Officers advised the male on said village ordinance. Call cleared with no violations observed at this time.
- **900 block of Mohawk Street, damage to property** – Caller reported vehicle damage that occurred overnight. Caller said the damage from a key or sharp object was observed after moving the parked vehicle during paving work. Patrols checked for video of the incident with negative results; report to come.
- **Niagara Scenic Parkway/Ridge Road, traffic complaint** – 911 caller reported a grey vehicle swerving, then speeding up; driver appeared to be falling asleep. Patrol checked area with negative results.
- **Franklin Street/Townline Road, traffic complaint** – 911 caller reported a dirt bike driving

up and down the roadway for 30 minutes. Patrols checked area with negative results.

- **100 block of N. Water Street, lost/found property** – Caller found a purse by a tree and turned it over to patrol. Report taken.
- **LPD patrols reported a vehicle/traffic stop for speed in zone with one uniform traffic ticket issued to the driver for Lewiston Town Court** – Patrols issued three warnings to other drivers for motor vehicle violations.

- **900 block of Mohawk Street, theft** – Caller reported the theft of credit and debit cards used in Buffalo. Caller was unaware of the theft until attempting a gas purchase; card accounts now secured. Patrol to follow up with Buffalo retailers for video footage. Report taken.

- **Location not listed, ordinance violation** – Complaint officer initiated. Patrol located several beer cans and cigarette butts that were discarded throughout a park area by a homeless male. Ordinance violation ticket to be issued.

- **Location not listed, check welfare** – Officer initiated. Patrol said the male caller had been locked inside a porta-pottie at the park. Officers responded and evicted the subject.

- **1200 block of Saunders Settlement Road, assist public** – Dispatch reported a 911 call with two parties screaming at each other in the background. Patrols found the subjects were arguing about a surgery the following morning. Subjects separated; all secure.
