

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Saturday, July 13, to Sunday, July 21, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD answered more than 400 calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Saturday, July 13

- **700 block of Center Street, assist public** – Caller reported a semi truck parked and idling outside during the early morning hours, filling the caller's residence with fumes. Vehicle moved soon after, resident called and wished to cancel.
- **700 block of Center Street, assist** – Caller reported juveniles blew off fireworks inside a store the prior evening; manager seeks report. Patrol viewed footage; report taken.
- **Swann/Creek roads, suspicious activity** – 911 caller reported a suspicious parked vehicle on the roadway. Patrol said the driver pulled off to the side of the road and was sleeping; driver advised to move along. Patrol cleared.
- **LPD patrols conducted one vehicle/traffic stop for speed in zone with one uniform traffic ticket issued to the driver for Lewiston Town Court** – Patrols issued nine warnings to other drivers for motor vehicle violations.

- **5800 block of Garlow Road, theft** – 911 caller reported the theft of a utility trailer. Patrols reported negative results on a vehicle search of the area and for any video footage. Report taken.

- **Ridge/Dickersonville roads, MVA-injuries** – 911 caller reported a two-vehicle accident, both with airbag deployment. Officers on scene; one driver cited for failure to yield the right of way, uniform traffic ticket issued for Lewiston Town Court. Vehicles towed, report taken.

- **900 block of Center Street, MVA-property damage** – 911 caller reported a two-vehicle accident in a supermarket parking lot. Patrol said the driver struck a parked vehicle and left the scene. LPD said the fleeing driver was then involved in the aforementioned four-vehicle MVA-injuries accident at Creek/Pletcher roads. V&T citations issued to driver; accident report taken.
- **100 block of N. Fourth Street, suspicious activity** – Caller reported hearing voices in a nearby park after hours. Patrols found kids playing; subjects advised the park was closed and left.
